Kia ora e te whaanau

Thank you to those that have responded to my October 21 communication requesting information that we are required to collect as legislated by the Covid-19 Public Health Response (Vaccinations) Order 2021. The order states that secondary schools are required to maintain an up-to-date register with the vaccine status of all eligible students. I have attached a privacy statement to inform you of how we will collect, store, use and share your personal information.

To enable Fairfield College to comply with the expectations outlined in the order we are requesting you to please submit your child/rens vaccine information, with supporting evidence, to the form which can be accessed [here](#). You will need to complete a separate form for each child you have currently attending Fairfield College. An appropriate form of evidence can be a screenshot from [My Covid Record](#), or a printout, which can be obtained by a call to your local GP/Nurse from the immunisation register. The card given at the time of appointment does not unfortunately contain the validated evidence that we are required to gain or record.

Vaccinations for Covid-19 will be offered at school on November 4

The Fairfield College Board of Trustees has approved that the school can be used as a site for students and staff to access the covid-19 vaccination. The vaccination will be provided by the Koiara Mobile Covid-19 Vaccination Clinic.

Student and Staff Vaccinations

This will take place from 12pm to 3pm on November 4. This is only for year 11, year 12, and year 13 students. The Board of Trustees have stated that all students must provide a parent consent form before the vaccination can be given. All forms will be checked before the vaccination is given.

Community Vaccinations

The Fairfield College Board of Trustees has also approved for the school to be used as a site for members of our community to access the covid-19 vaccination. This will take place on November 4 from 4pm to 7pm. The Koiara Mobile Covid-19 Vaccination Clinic will be operating both a drive in and walk in system. Year 9 and Year 10 students with their whaanau could access the vaccination at this time as all of our senior students and most of our staff will be off the school site by 3:45pm.
