The purpose of this communication is to inform you that Fairfield College continues to follow the Ministry of Education's directive that schools be open for all students irrespective of their Covid-19 vaccination status.

However, there are situations outside of the school's control where unvaccinated students access to educational opportunities will be restricted. An example of this is the school's work experience programme. Work experience is a key part of the learning programme that we offer in our Pathways Faculty. We have been informed from our student work experience providers that presentation of a Covid-19 vaccination passport is a requirement for students to participate in this programme.

There is also a full Covid-19 vaccination requirement for students who want to participate in sports that are sanctioned by the Waikato Secondary School Sports Principals Association. This also includes all events on the School Sport NZ sanctioned calendar for 2022.
